

Pretty Little Pots

By Wendy Williams 25. Paige's Pot

Finished size: 4 1/4" x 6"





Requirements:

Background fabric: 6" x 8"

Wool: 3" x 3" purple, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" medium green,

80 weight thread (or similar): neutral

Batting: 2 1/2" x 2"

Cotton for pot: 3 1/2" x 3" Cotton fabric motif for reverse applique 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Freezer paper

Cutting:

- 1. Cut out the background fabric 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7". The block will be trimmed when finished to 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 2. Cut out the pot (T) in cardboard and batting
- 3. Cut out the fabric for the pot allowing approx. 1/2" seam allowance around all edges.

Making: Little Pot

As before

- 1. Place the batting onto the cardboard pot shape.
- 2. Place the fabric over the batting and glue to the underside of the cardboard. Try to fold the fabric over as tight as possible.
- 3. Press the fabric from the right side and then again from the underside. Allow to cool and then carefully remove the cardboard. (a cuticle stick is helpful for this)
- 4. Using the template as a guide for placement, pin the pot into position.
- 5. Stitch with small slip stitches to attach the pot to the background.


Flower, leaf and stem:

The flower for this one is made with reverse applique as before.

- 1. Trace the patterns for the flower circles and leaves onto freezer paper and cut out. Cut out a 'hole' in the centre of the smaller circle big enough to reveal the flower motif.
- 2. Cut out your flower motif approx. 3/8" larger than the hole.
- 3. Pin the fabric flower motif under the centre circle and to the larger circle. Stitch through all layers with a round of whip stitch. Stitch a round of colonial knots around the inner edge of the wool and at the end of the whip stitches.
- 4. Pin the flower to the background and stitch around the outer edge with cross stitch.
- 5. Chalk on the line for the stem. Stitch this with 3 rows of stem stitch.
- Chalk on the outline of the leaf. Stitch around the edge with 2 rows of stem stitch. Stitch a row of zig zag through the centre of the leaf.

Note- the lines are shown to indicate the correct size as a guide for printing.


