

Pretty Little Pots

By Wendy Williams 34. Peyton's Pot

Finished size: 4 1/4" x 6 3/4"





Requirements:

Background fabric: 6" x 8"

Wool: 3 1/2" x 4" mauve, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" light blue, 2" x 3" medium green

80 weight thread (or similar): neutral.

Batting: 2 ½" x 3"
Cotton for pot: 4" x 3"

Freezer paper

Cutting:

- Cut out the background fabric 5 ¼" x 7 ¾"
 The block will be trimmed when finished to 4 ¾" x 7 ¼"
- 2. Cut out the pot (N) in cardboard and batting
- 3. Cut out the fabric for the pot allowing approx. 1/2" seam allowance around all edges.

Making: Little Pot

As before


- 1. Place the batting onto the cardboard pot shape.
- 2. Place the fabric over the batting and glue to the underside of the cardboard. Try to fold the fabric over as tight as possible.
- 3. Press the fabric from the right side and then again from the underside. Allow to cool and then carefully remove the cardboard. (a cuticle stick is helpful for this)
- 4. Using the template as a guide for placement, pin the pot into position.
- 5. Stitch with small slip stitches to attach the pot to the background.

Flower, stem and leaves:

- Trace the pattern for the flower circles and leaves onto freezer paper and cut out. (Or use your circle templates).
- 2. Cut a small 'hole' in the centre of the smaller circle.
- 3. Stitch the smallest circle to the medium circle with whip stitch. Add a round of colonial knots around the outer edge of the circle. Fill the 'hole' in the centre with colonial knots.
- 4. Stitch this circle to the larger circle again with a round of whip stitch. Add the colonial knots around the outer edge.
- 5. Stitch the flower to the background with zig zag. Add a round of colonial knots into the 'V's' of the zigzag. (refer to photo and template).
- Chalk on the outer lines of the stem. Stitch a row of zig zag between the lines. Add some colonial knot between the stitches.
- 7. Stitch the leaves to the background with small whip stitches and a row of backstitch through the centre.

Note- the lines are shown to indicate the correct size as a guide for printing.




Stitch guide:
