



# Pretty Little Pots

Sashing and Borders

Finished size: 56 1/4" x 54 1/4"

**Materials:** 2 yds (1.6m)

## Cutting:

### Sashing:

note- strips are cut across the width of the fabric

1. Horizontal sashing  
Cut 6 x 1 1/4" strips  
Cross cut to yield 44, 1 1/4" x 4 3/4" pieces
2. Vertical sashing  
Cut 9 x 1 1/4" strips
3. Fillers for above and below alternate rows  
Cut 1 x 4 3/4" strip

Cross cut to:

- 4 3/4" x 3 3/4"
- 4 3/4" x 3 1/2"
- 4 3/4" x 3 1/4"
- 4 3/4" x 2 1/2"
- 4 3/4" x 2 1/4"
- 4 3/4" x 2"
- 4 3/4" x 5"
- 4 3/4" x 4 1/2"

4. Outer borders  
Cut 5, 6 1/2" strips for the outer borders

## Making:

Lay out your blocks on a design wall (or table) and place them according to the layout diagram. Where the sizes are the same you can switch them around.

1. Stitch the small sashing strips between the vertical blocks. Press the seams towards the sashing.
2. Stitch the filler sashing pieces to the upper and lower blocks on rows 2, 4, 6 and 8
3. Stitch the sashing strips together and crosscut them to yield 8, 44 3/4" strips.
4. Stitch these strips between each of the rows. Press the seams towards the sashing.
5. Stitch the border strips together and crosscut to yield 2 pieces 6 1/2" x 44 3/4" and  
2 pieces 6 1/2" x 54 3/4"
6. Stitch the shorter pieces to the upper and lower edges and press.  
Stitch the longer pieces to the sides.
